

## **CITY OF HAZEN RECOGNIZED FOR SAFE DRINKING WATER ACT COMPLIANCE**

Public water systems are required by the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) to take many actions to provide safe drinking water.

SDWA was passed by Congress in 1974 to protect public health by regulating the nation's public drinking water supplies. Over the years, there have been a number of changes to the Safe Drinking Water Act. These changes have made it more challenging to maintain compliance. The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality issues a Safe Drinking Water Act Certificate of Achievement as one way of recognizing the public water systems that satisfied all applicable requirements during the previous calendar year.

In 2025, the City of Hazen complied with all applicable Safe Drinking Water Act requirements. To recognize this accomplishment, the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality issued the City of Hazen a Safe Drinking Water Act Certificate of Achievement.
